

## 2021 Miss Lindsay's Art Camp FAQ

\*Children should eat breakfast and use the restroom/wash hands before entering the park, to minimize hunger pains and having to use the bathroom during camp. Please bring a water, and small snack if needed. A teacher will escort students to the bathroom as needed

\*Parents are to walk their children to the pavilion.

\*Parents are to check their children for a fever prior to arrival. Teachers will ask parents/students upon arrival if they have a fever, or if the child has been sick (headaches, fever, chills, etc) in the last 3-7 days. If so, the child cannot attend camp. A digital thermometer may be used.

\*Masks are not mandatory. The decision to wear a mask is up to the individual student/parents, and teachers. It will not be enforced by the teachers.

\*Students will sit 2 per table, max 20 students in pavilion. Everyone will remain seated during the camp except 2 teachers. Tables are 6ft apart.

\*No art supplies will be shared, and all students will have individual art supply packs. Individual water cups for paint, paper plate palettes and paper towels will be provided.

\*Cleaning supplies will be present and used as necessary. Hand sanitizer and wipes will be provided. All children will be asked to use hand sanitizer upon arrival.
