

Pickleball Court Rotation Rules

1. - All levels Open Play Rotation Rules: Mon.-Sun. from 8am - 12:00Pm (NO THURSDAY DUE TO LADDERS)

-All levels Open Play Rotation Rules Mon-Friday 6pm to Dusk (NO Wednesday DUE TO LADDERS)

WB Parks programs take priority

2. First Come, First Served and time is limited to one hour on the court. (Anytime during non-rotation play)
3. Doubles play has priority over singles play.
4. When ready to play, place paddle in the left side of the holder.
5. Play begins when enough players arrive to make a foursome. Games consist of eleven (11) points win by two (2).
6. When a team wins a game, the two (2) winning players remain on the court and two (2) new players are rotated in. Players are rotated on the court according to the position of their paddle in the holder.
7. When there are players waiting, if a player has played 2 consecutive games on a court, player **MUST** leave the court and place their paddle in the holder to let others play.



8. When there are 6 or less paddles in the holder, there will be a 2 on/2 off rotation- winners stay on and losers come off. When there are 7 or more paddles in the holder, there will be a 4 on/4 off rotation. All four players leave the court.
9. If a player decides to rest or take a break, their paddle should not be placed in rotation until they are ready to resume playing and then shall be placed at the end of the queue.
10. If a group of players wish to stay together and go onto a court all at once, they may move other paddles ahead of their paddles, in order to all get on the court together. However, they cannot proceed to play on the court until prior paddles are on the court.
11. Anyone not present when their paddle is at the front of the queue when the game on the court ends, will lose their turn and their paddle will be placed at the back of the queue.
12. Do not enter courts, until play had stopped. Please close gate when entering the courts.
13. If someone falls on the court, all play STOPS until their needs are addressed.
14. Please be courteous in the courtyard. No bags on the table and/or benches. Place bags along the fence line. Label bags, jackets and paddles. Throw trash and recycle bottles in designated bins. Close gates when exiting courts.
